The first mention of Zion is in the Old Testament, when King David and his army claimed the city of Jerusalem from a tribe called the Jebusites (II Samuel 5:7, 9). From then on, Jerusalem was often called either Zion or the "city of David."

This prophecy was given over 700 years before Jesus was born!

1 | 139:8-9

The Christian era was ushered in with signs and wonders.

2 | 95:23

Led by a solitary star amid the darkness, the Magi of old foretold the Messiahship of Truth. Is the wise man of today believed, when he beholds the light which heralds Christ's eternal dawn and describes its effulgence?

3 | vii:10

The Wisemen were led to behold and to follow this daystar of divine Science, lighting the way to eternal harmony.

4 | 146:23

Divine Science derives its sanction from the Bible, and the divine origin of Science is demonstrated through the holy influence of Truth in healing sickness and sin. This healing power of Truth must have been far anterior to the period in which Jesus lived. It is as ancient as "the Ancient of days." It lives through all Life, and extends throughout all space.

5 | 107:1-3, 7

In the year 1866, I discovered the Christian Science Christ Science or divine laws of Life, Truth, and Love, and named my discovery Christian Science.

This apodictical Principle points
to the revelation of Immanuel, "God Christian Science with us," — the sovereign ever-presence, delivering the children of men from every ill "that flesh is heir to." Through Christian Science, religion and medicine are inspired with a diviner nature and essence; fresh pinions are given to faith and understanding, and thoughts acquaint themselves intelligently with God.

6 | 109:24

When a new spiritual idea is borne to earth, the prophetic Scripture of Isaiah is renewedly fulfilled: "Unto us a child is born, . . . and his name shall be called Wonderful."

7 | 29:32-1

Jesus was the offspring of Mary's self-conscious communion with God.

8 | 29:14-26

Those instructed in Christian

Science have reached the glorious

perception that God is the only author of man.

The Virgin-mother conceived this idea of God, and gave to her ideal the name of Jesus — that is, Joshua, or Saviour.

The illumination of Mary's spiritual sense put to silence material law and its order of generation, and brought forth her child by the revelation of Truth, demonstrating God as the Father of men. The Holy Ghost, or divine Spirit, overshadowed the pure sense of the Virgin-mother with the full recognition that being is Spirit.

9 | 546:23-26



Christian Science is dawning upon a material age. The great spiritual facts of being, like rays of light, shine in the darkness, though the darkness, comprehending them not, may deny their reality.

10 | 191:8

As a material, theoretical life-basis
is found to be a misapprehension of
existence, the spiritual and divine Principle of
man dawns upon human thought, and leads it to
"where the young child was," — even to the birth
of a new-old idea, to the spiritual sense of being
and of what Life includes. Thus the whole earth
will be transformed by Truth on its pinions of light,
chasing away the darkness of error.

Luke 1:26

The angel Gabriel appears three times in the Bible: first to Daniel (Daniel 8:15–17; 9:21), then to Zacharias (Luke 1:19), and finally to Mary. The original Hebrew word *Gabriyel* is often translated as "man of God" or "warrior of God."

Bible Dive

Luke 1:27

Prophecies given long before Jesus's birth described how the promised Messiah would be a descendant of David (see Isaiah 11:1–4 and Jeremiah 23:5). God had promised David that one of his offspring would fulfill a special role (II Samuel 7:12, 13). Many times in the Gospels, Jesus is called the "son of David."

Luke 1:28

"Hail" was a kind of greeting that meant "be well," "be glad," or even "rejoice."

12 | 299:11-15



15 | 14:6

To be "present with the Lord" is to have, not mere emotional ecstasy or faith, but the actual demonstration and understanding of Life as revealed in Christian Science. To be "with the Lord" is to be in obedience to the law of God, to be absolutely governed by divine Love, — by Spirit, not by matter.

16 | 127:4

If God, the All-in-all, be the creator of the spiritual universe, including Christianity man, then everything entitled to a classification as truth, or Science, must be comprised in a knowledge or understanding of God, for there can be nothing beyond illimitable divinity.





Shepherds led sheep to food and water each day and returned them to the fold every evening. This job wasn't for the faint of heart—it required diligence and endurance! Sometimes searching for good pasture took the shepherd far from home, and he was always on guard against wild animals and thieves.

The incarnation of Truth, that amplification of wonder and glory which angels could only whisper and which God illustrated by light and harmony, is consonant with ever-present Love.

18 | 323:28-30, 32-2

The effects of Christian Science are not so much seen as felt. It is the "still, small voice" of Truth uttering itself.

Childlike receptivity

Willingness to become as a little child and to leave the old for the new, renders thought receptive of the advanced idea.

19 | vii:2-10

The wakeful shepherd beholds the first faint morning beams, ere cometh the full radiance of a risen day. So shone the pale star to the prophet-shepherds; yet it traversed the night, and came where, in cradled obscurity, lay the Bethlehem babe, the human herald of Christ, Truth, who would make plain to benighted understanding the way of salvation through Christ Jesus, till across a night of error should dawn the morning beams and shine the guiding star of being.





Jesus wasn't the only one to have prophecies spoken of him! John the Baptist's work is linked to a prophecy given by Isaiah (also known as Esaias) in Isaiah 40:3.

23 | xi:9-21

The physical healing of Christian Science results now, as in Jesus' time, from the operation of divine Principle, before which sin and disease lose their reality in human consciousness and disappear as naturally and as necessarily as darkness gives place to light and sin to reformation. Now, as then, these mighty works are not supernatural, but supremely natural. They are the sign of Immanuel, or "God with us," — a divine influence ever present in human consciousness and repeating itself, coming now as was promised aforetime,

To preach deliverance to the captives [of sense], And recovering of sight to the blind, To set at liberty them that are bruised.

24 | 46:7

The divine Spirit, which identified Spiritual Jesus thus centuries ago, has spoken interpretation through the inspired Word and will speak through it in every age and clime. It is revealed to the receptive heart, and is again seen casting out evil and healing the sick.

25 | 494:11

It is not well to imagine that Jesus demonstrated the divine power to heal only for a select number or for a limited period of time, since to all mankind and in every hour, divine Love supplies all good.

26 | 150:4-8

To-day the healing power of Truth
is widely demonstrated as an immanent,
eternal Science, instead of a phenomenal exhibition. Its appearing is the coming anew of the
gospel of "on earth peace, good-will toward men."

27 | 496:15

Hold perpetually this thought, — that it is the spiritual idea, the Holy Ghost and Christ, which enables you to demonstrate, with scientific certainty, the rule of healing, based upon its divine Principle, Love, underlying, overlying, and encompassing all true being.



In the New Testament, the word "Comforter" appears only in the book of John. The "Comforter" (parakletos in Greek) also means "advocate." During a time of trial, an advocate stays by someone's side to offer aid, counsel, and defense.

"Grace" comes from the Greek word *charis*, which can mean lovingkindness, thankfulness, supply, and that which brings joy and gratitude.

28 | 497:5

We acknowledge and adore one supreme and infinite God. We acknowledge His Son, one Christ; the Holy Ghost or divine Comforter; and man in God's image and likeness.

29 | 55:15-16, 22-29

Truth's immortal idea is sweeping down the centuries, gathering beneath its wings the sick and sinning.

The time for the reappearing of the divine healing is throughout all time; and whosoever layeth his earthly all on the altar of divine Science, drinketh of Christ's cup now, and is endued with the spirit and power of Christian healing.
